

Species names homonymy in the ladybirds (Coleoptera: Coccinellidae). II

ABSTRACT. The species names *Exochomus minutus* Gordon, 1974, *Zenoria peruviana* Gordon, 1972, *Scymnus simulans* Gordon, 1976, *Scymnus triangularis* Gordon, 2001, *Scymnus hamatus* Gordon, 2001, *Scymnus klapperichi* Pang et Gordon, 1986, *Scymnus dubius* (Weise, 1929) and *Scymnus brunneus* (Fürsch, 1997) have proved to be preoccupied. In present contribution the new replacement names for the above mentioned species-group taxa are established: *Exochomus oaxacus* **nom.nov.** — for the junior homonym *Exochomus minutus* Gordon, 1974 (non Kraatz, 1873); *Zenoria gordonii* **nom.nov.** — for *Zenoria peruviana* Gordon, 1972 (non Kirsch, 1876); *Scymnus onagus* **nom.nov.** — for *Scymnus simulans* Gordon, 1976 (non Mader, 1950); *Scymnus pesenkoi* **nom.nov.** — for *Scymnus triangularis* Gordon, 2001 (non Lea, 1902); *Scymnus rohndendorfi* **nom.nov.** — for *Scymnus hamatus* Gordon, 2001 (non Weise, 1895); *Scymnus filippovi* **nom.nov.** — for *Scymnus klapperichi* Pang et Gordon, 1986 (non Mader, 1955); *Scymnus zhidkovi* **nom.nov.** — for *Scymnus dubius* (Weise, 1929) (non Jordan, 1894); *Scymnus linnei* **nom.nov.** — for *Scymnus brunneus* (Fürsch, 1997) (non Gorham, 1884).

РЕЗЮМЕ. Видовые названия *Exochomus minutus* Gordon, 1974, *Zenoria peruviana* Gordon, 1972, *Scymnus simulans* Gordon, 1976, *Scymnus triangularis* Gordon, 2001, *Scymnus hamatus* Gordon, 2001, *Scymnus klapperichi* Pang et Gordon, 1986, *Scymnus dubius* (Weise, 1929) и *Scymnus brunneus* (Fürsch, 1997) оказались преокупированными. В настоящей работе устанавливаются новые замещающие названия для указанных таксонов видовой группы: *Exochomus oaxacus* **nom.nov.** — для младшего омонима *Exochomus minutus* Gordon, 1974 (non Kraatz, 1873); *Zenoria gordonii* **nom.nov.** — для *Zenoria peruviana* Gordon, 1972 (non Kirsch, 1876); *Scymnus onagus* **nom.nov.** — для *Scymnus simulans* Gordon, 1976 (non Mader, 1950); *Scymnus pesenkoi* **nom.nov.** — для *Scymnus triangularis* Gordon,

2001 (non Lea, 1902); *Scymnus rohndendorfi* **nom.nov.** — для *Scymnus hamatus* Gordon, 2001 (non Weise, 1895); *Scymnus filippovi* **nom.nov.** — для *Scymnus klapperichi* Pang et Gordon, 1986 (non Mader, 1955); *Scymnus zhidkovi* **nom.nov.** — для *Scymnus dubius* (Weise, 1929) (non Jordan, 1894); *Scymnus linnei* **nom.nov.** — для *Scymnus brunneus* (Fürsch, 1997) (non Gorham, 1884).

As a result of Coccinellidae family species names nomenclature studying it became possible to find out the previously overlooked primary homonymy in six cases. According to the International Code of Zoological Nomenclature [1999, articles 52, 53.3, 57, 60], six new names are proposed for the junior primary homonyms without available synonyms.

ETYMOLOGY. The species is named in honour of the famous Soviet palaeoentomologist Boris Borisovich Rohdendorf (1904–1977).

ETYMOLOGY. The species is named in honour of the famous Soviet ladybird collector Nicolay Nicolaevich Filipov (1895–1972).

Two previously overlooked cases of secondary homonymy were revealed. According to the International Code of Zoological Nomenclature [1999, articles 52, 53.3, 57.3, 59, 60], one new name is proposed for the junior secondary homonym without available synonyms and one more new name is introduced for the junior secondary homonym, the only synonym of which has already been preoccupied and because of that could not be valid.
